PUBLIC HEALTH WALES ADVICE FOR THOSE SELF ISOLATING (AS OF 18/03/20)

Clean frequently touched surfaces with household products like detergents and bleach on a regular basis especially before and after possible contamination e.g. before and after meal preparation on kitchen work surfaces.

DO NOT put tissues and disposable cleaning cloths directly into your household waste. You should firstly double bag them and keep them securely and separately for at least 72 hours before putting them in your general waste.

Wash your clothes as normal but ensure you don't shake the clothes beforehand in order to limit the spread of the virus from your clothes. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A WASHING MACHINE wait a further 72 hrs after your isolation time has ended before taking them to a public laundromat.

Make sure you drink plenty of water. You can also take over the counter medicines such as paracetamol to help with your symptoms if you need to.

DO NOT invite or allow in social visitors such as friends and family during your self isolation period.
