# EC5/24-25 CHRISTMAS CONCERT 2024

The had been resolved at the February 2024 Ordinary Council meeting:

- All councillors to commit to assisting at their ward concert.
- Involve the schoolchildren from the host ward.

- To approach Blaengarw Primary School to see if the schoolchildren would sing at the concert, ask what date is suitable and ask them to sell tickets through the school.
- To approach Blaengarw Workmen's Hall to check availability for Friday's in December.
- To ask Councillor Deb Davies to prepare the marketing materials
